A New Die for Elizabeth I 1574 Acorn Initial Mark Threepence's

In The Galata Guide to Hammered and Milled Threepenny Pieces 1551 - 1662, published in 2016 by Galata Print, I recorded two pair of dies for the very rare 1574 acorn initial mark threepence's designated 1i and 1ii for the obverse and Ai and Aii for the reverse. These were represented by eight existing specimens, five with the pairing 1i/AI, one with the pairing 1i/Aii and two with the pairing 1ii/Aii. Since publication another three specimens have come to light two of which have a third reverse die, now designated Aiii, and one of which has a new obverse die 1iii. On checking these coins against the previously known specimens it happens that one of the 1i/Ai specimens in the Museum of Somerset (MoS 15.N.52) is able to be die-linked to the new Aiii reverse.

The current tally for 1574 Acorn threepence's is now 1i/Ai - five, 1i/Aii - one, 1i/Aiii - one, 1ii/Aiii - one, 1ii/Aiii - one, 1ii/Aiii - one, 1ii/Aiii - one

The coins from the new dies were purchased at the London Coin fair and from E-bay.

To differentiate the three dies note the positioning of the Acorn initial mark to the cross on the top of the crown and also the orientation and positioning of the Rose behind the bust.

To differentiate amongst the three dies note the positioning of the stops at the end of the reverse legend and the positioning of the numbers in the date.
