

Insights into Henry VI Rosette Mascle Pence

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The issue of coins from the period 1430 - 1431 are given the appellation Rosette Mascle issues due to the inclusion of these marks as stops in the obverse and reverse legend and is found for all the coinage denominations from London and Calais and for the pence only for the mints of York and Durham.

In his work 'The Heavy coinage of Henry VI. Part II' published in the British Numismatic Journal Vol 23 (1938-41) pp 205-67 C.A Whitton describes the silver coins of London as scarce compared to the issue from Calais and for the pence of London they occur with 3 initial marks V, IIIa and IIIb, and rosette and mascle stops



The London pence he lists with initial mark V have only saltire stops on the obverse and mascle or rosette stops on the reverse and are regarded as Mules with Annulet issue obverses - C.A.W. 3c and 3d.

For the pence with just mascle stops or rosette and mascle stops, are only listed from initial mark IIIb and are regarded as the true Rosette mascle issues - C.A.W. 5a and 6a. These coins are also found muled with the subsequent pinecone mascle obverses - C.A.W. 7a.

For the Calais pence the obverses with initial mark v are found with saltire stops only and with rosette and mascle stops - C.A.W. 5 and C.A.W. 6.

The coins with saltire stops only are regarded as Rosette Mascle issues due to the absence of annulets by the bust.

The Calais penny coins with initial mark IIIa and initial mark IIIb on the obverse are found with rosette and mascle stops - C.A.W. 7, C.A.W. 8a and C.A.W. 8b.

As with London those with initial mark IIIb are also found muled with the Pinecone Mascle issue reverses. Pinecone mascle/Rosette mascle mules for Calais are also known.

This classification is maintained in both J. J. North 'English Hammered Coins Volume II' (N 1449 - 1452) and also in Spink's 'Coins of England' (S 1864 - 1869).

Recently I acquired through a facebook auction a London rosette/mascle issue penny that does not conform to the accepted classification.



The coin has initial mark V and reads **+HENRICVS: REX: ANGLIE**
The reverse reads **DIVI: TRES: / LON: DON: •**

The missing portion of the legend being supplied from a die duplicate of the coin in the late Ivan Buck collection. (this coin being from the same obverse die but in a later state where the initial mark had been altered to simulate a IIIb initial mark).

This discovery could mean either the coin was a true London Rosette Mascle issue penny with IM V or that the coin was a Calais London mule. This second option I discounted for the following reason. On examining existing specimens of the London rosette mascle I noticed that the Ivan Buck specimen despite being listed as having initial mark IIIb is a die duplicate of my specimen but in a worn state and with an altered initial mark (presumably altering cross V to simulate cross IIIb). This specimen allows us to fill in the missing gaps in the legend of the new coin. I have been unable to link the obverse die to any of the Calais Rosette Mascle issue pennies I have examined and must conclude that the die is a true London die.

This discovery brings into question the attribution of some of the Annulet /Rosette Mascle mules of London. The use of the initial mark V with mascle stops for London suggests that some of the previously attributed mules be re-designated as 1st unmarked issue, first proposed by Withers in the Galata guide. 'Small Change - III The Halfpennies and Farthings of Henry IV, V and VI'. Galata Print 2003
