
# Henry III, Posthumous Class 7, Obverse Die Types


This article is actually a report generated directly from a Microsoft Access database, allowing easy update in the future, and it documents the known class 7 obverse dies from the mints at London, Bury and Durham. One example is illustrated for each of the known dies.

Class 7 pennies of both Bury and Durham are rare, with very few documented examples. There are more known for Renaud of London, and commonest of all are those of Phelip of London, there being almost 60 of these known. There are undoubtedly further examples from all three mints in private collections, and I would like to appeal to anyone having specimens to kindly send images to me to aid further die study. I can be contacted using the comment form on the blog.

I have been collecting images of class 7 coins for a number of years, and the full pennies known to me are summarised in this table...



The coins are in varying states of preservation, and some of the coin images I have been able to obtain are not of high resolution, nevertheless, I have identified the following number of different dies, all which are illustrated by a type example in this article.



There are sufficient different dies of the London coins to allow some grouping of different groups of dies. This grouping is based on three parameters: (a) The type of sceptre head, (b) whether there is a Lombadic "U" or a Roman "V" in the king's name, and (c) what punctuation, if any, is present after "REX". The die groupings are summarised in the table overleaf.

To determine the obverse die type for a London coin of Renaud or Phelip, first determine the die group and then look in the appropriate section to locate the appropriate die match. For coins of Bury or Durham go straight to the die descriptions. If you cannot locate a matching obverse die you may have an unrecorded die, in which case I would appreciate you contacting me so that this listing may be updated.

The timing of when these coins were issued will be discussed in a future article, however the relative chronology of London coins of types 7a, 7b, 7c, and then the 7d to 7i pennies, is probably correct. Within the 7d to 7i types there is no relative chronology implied by the lettering; the relative chronology determination is dependent upon a future die-pairing study which is currently underway. Note that the various die groups should be referred to as "obverse types", and should not be considered as sub-classes.

The determination of a particular die is by means of a set of attributes; quite a number of attributes have been defined in order to maximise the chance of a positive identification. Keep in mind that it will not be possible to determine all the attributes on some coins due to wear. The attributes utilised are explained below.

Obv "U"/"V"..... King's name spelt with a "U" or a "V"

PRT...... The number of pellets in the inner circle counting anticlockwise from sceptre to RH edge of the crown.

LNL...... The number of the pellet, counting from the sceptre, which the left-hand neckline touches.

VP...... For obverses with a "V" - base of V touches which number pellet counting clockwise from the crown.

As regards the dies of Phelip there is sufficent data to allow a statistical estimation of the total number of Phelip obverse dies that may exist using the equations proposed by Warren Esty. This methodolgy was described in a recent Research Blog article by Gary Oddie (April 23rd 2023). Using the Esty equations and applying them to this Phelip data set the following is obtained:

Phelip dies observed: 23 Predicted number of obverse dies: 35

Sceptre Head..... Simple (single) sceptre head, or compound (double) sceptre head.

For the statistically minded, the 95% range of possible outcomes is 27 to 46 obverse dies, and the coverage factor is 0.8167

This new prediction of the number of obverse dies is very different from the 96 dies that I predicted in September 2020; this will be discussed further in a forthcoming article addressing the production from the London mint. As further information becomes available I will revise this article, and as the number of specimens increases it will be possible to further refine the estimated number of total obverse dies.




